PERSONAL

Pastor Gary was born on April 29, 1943, in Everett, PA to Ralph M. And Lelia C. (O'Neil) Trail, the youngest of six children to a teaching and farming family. He was married to E. Elaine Burkett for 40 years and divorced in March 2005. They were blessed with two children, Gary II and Michele. They have 9 grandchildren and 2 great-grandchildren. Pastor Gary married The Rev. Mary Stevens Trail, the widow of The Rev. Glenn F. Stevens, on May 29, 2006. This marriage added four more children and 10 more grandchildren.

CHURCH LIFE

Pastor Gary was Baptized and Confirmed in Chaneyville United Methodist Church. He was licensed to preach in 1962 at the Central PA Conference. He served as pastor in PA churches from 1963 to 1966 (Student Pastorates). He became an Ordained Deacon in 1965, and had pastorates in the Peninsula-Delaware Conference from 1966 through 1980. Pastor Gary became an Ordained Elder at Wilmington, DE in 1967. He served the following churches:
